SUBJECT

Amendment to Professional Services Agreement with Aquatech Septic & Underground, LLC (Aquatech)

BACKGROUND

On March 3, 2023, EPWater entered into a Professional Services Agreement with Aquatech Septic & Underground, LLC for regulatory compliance sampling services for a term of five years not to exceed \$100,000 pursuant to the delegated signature authority of the President/CEO. This contract allows Aquatech to continue regulatory compliance sampling for Vinton Village Estates after EPWater assumed responsibility for overseeing the Public Water Systems (PWS.) Since then, EPWater has become responsible for three additional PWSs within Vinton, Vinton Alegre Estates, Hillside Water Works, and Vinton Hills Subdivision. At this time, \$520,000 of additional capacity is needed beyond the delegated authority to ensure EPWater can continue to use Aquatech to complete the regulatory compliance sampling that is required for all four PWSs within Vinton for the remaining four years.

STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES SUPPORTED

Increase Customer Satisfaction & Confidence

EVALUATION PROCESS

Staff reviewed and evaluated the current professional services contract and determined that additional capacity is needed to continue the regulatory compliance sampling. Aquatech Septic & Underground, LLC has been a reliable, responsive, and qualified local vendor. They have required licenses by TCEQ to provide the services. These professional services are exempt from bidding requirements under Chapter 2254 of the Texas Government Code.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Sufficient funds are available in account number 7720, and the funding source is the Water and Sewer Fund.

PROPOSED ACTION REQUESTED

Consider and approve an Amendment to Professional Services Agreement with Aquatech Septic & Underground, LLC, pursuant to Chapter 2254 of the Texas Government Code, to increase the capacity of the agreement for regulatory compliance sampling services by an additional \$520,000 to increase the cumulative agreement amount to \$620,000 for the remaining term of the contract, contingent upon Aquatech maintaining and providing their valid TCEQ licensure.

IMPORTANT NOTE: This proposal is based on 4 separate PWS, once all the PWS are consolidated we will revisit and provide a new proposal, as reportings and samplings will be on a different schedule.

We are pleased to offer our proposal for the following services for the above-mentioned Public Water Systems.

The following pricing is per each PWS.

Water Operator Scope of Work:

INCLUSIONS:

WEEKLY OPERATIONAL DUTIES: \$1,500.00/ month for 1 PWS, \$1,000 each additional PWS

Collect a weekly distribution disinfectant residual and maintain records for 2 years.

MONTHLY OPERATIONAL DUTIES: \$1,250.00/ month for 1 PWS, \$875 each additional PWS

MONTHLY COLLECTION OF ONE BACTERIOLOGICAL SAMPLE:

Collect a Coliform (bacteriological) sample and submit to an accredited lab for analysis. Maintain record of results for 5 years.

QUARTERLY OPERATIONAL DUTIES: \$1,900.00/ quarterly for 1 PWS, \$1,330 each additional PWS PREPARATION &

SUBMITTAL OF DISIFECTANT LEVEL QUARTERLY OPERATIONAL REPORT (DLOOR):

Recordkeeping of weekly disinfectant residual and maintain records for 2 years.

ANNUAL OPERATIONAL DUTIES: \$1,000.00/ yearly for 1 PWS, \$700 each additional PWS

Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) sent to customers by July 1 for previous year; CCR + Certificate of Delivery (COD) to TCEQ by July 1 for previous year (if you are a Community PWS):

EVERY 3 YR OPERATIONAL DUTIES: \$2,500.00/every 3 years per PWS

LEAD & COPPER TAP SAMPLE MONITORING:

Lead & Copper Tap Sample Monitoring due in September 2023. Collect a Lead & Copper sample @ 5 designated residences and submit to an accredited lab for analysis. Submit the results to TCEQ. To include container distribution, sample collection and shipping of samples to LCRA. Notification of results to customers sampled and any other reporting requirements.

EXCLUSIONS:

The following reporting's per PWS as required by TCEQ:

- Operations and Maintenance Manual
- 2. Monitoring Plan
- 3. Sample Site Plan, develop a sample site plan that includes a map showing sample sites where chlorine residuals and coliform samples are collected.
- 4. **Emergency Action Plan**

- 7. Customer Service Inspection/Cross-Connection Control Program
- System Map (will need copy existing map) 8.
- 9. SOP's (Standard Operating Procedures) for Bacteria sample collection; chlorine residual testing; maintenance activities; etc.
- 10. Flushing Logs
- 11. Customer Complaint Logs
- 12. Annual Tank Inspection Forms
- 13. Respond any TCEO correspondence.
- 14. Yearly Water Use Survey & Water Loss Audit Report to Texas Water Development Board
- 15. All water mater repairs or any water lines
- 16. Meter Readings
- 17. Customer billing

Water Operator/ Aquatech will not be responsible for ANY other TCEQ requirements not listed in the inclusions of this

proposal.
