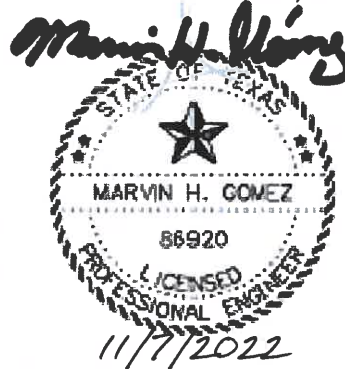

ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF THIS ADDENDUM BY INSERTING ITS NUMBER IN THE SPACE PROVIDED ON THE BID FORM.

Attention of all bidders is directed to the following modifications made hereby to the quantities of the Bid Form for the Items listed below in response to questions regarding the quantities for the Items listed.

See response for each question, below:

QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

1. **QUESTION: Bid Item #3 (Silt Fence) states 1075 LF but plans show approx. 2535 LF. Please advise.**

RESPONSE: The silt fence quantity originally given did not include the area near Edgar Rd. and Ethel Rd. As such, the revised quantity for Item #3, Furnish, Install and Remove Temporary Silt Fence shall be approximately 2,577 linear feet. The attached bid form has been adjusted with this revised quantity.

2. **QUESTION: Bid Item #15 (Handrail) states 33 LF but plans show approx. 60 LF. Please advise.**

RESPONSE: The proposed handrail crossing the spillway flume is approximately 33 linear feet. Only the street side of the crossing requires a handrail. The flume side has a wrought iron fence along the width of the flume adjacent to the sidewalk.

3. **QUESTION: Bid Item #20 (Embankment Wall) states 7125 SF but plans show approx. 3350 SF. Please advise.**

RESPONSE: The actual amount of square footage for the proposed embankment wall includes the footing for the wall because of its size, as specified in the technical specifications. Contractor should include the footing square footage in their estimate for Item #20.

4. **QUESTION: Bid Item #23 (Wrought Iron Fence w Signs) states 30 LF but plans show approx. 153 LF. Please advise.**

RESPONSE: The proposed wrought iron fencing running parallel with the embankment was not included with the total. The revised total for Item 23, Furnish and Install Proposed Custom Wrought Iron Fence with Signs amount should be approximately 153 linear feet.
